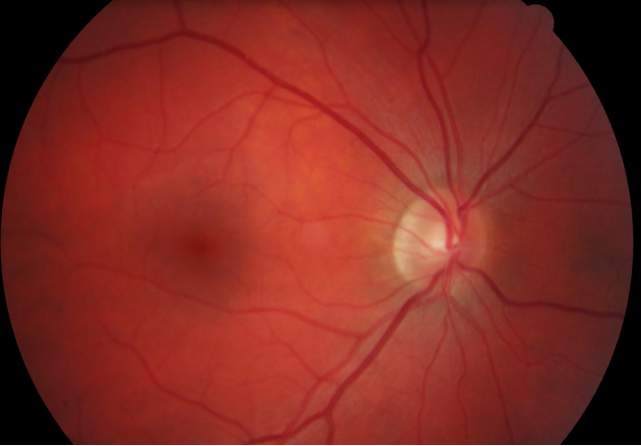

Digital Retinal Imaging
(DRI)



What is Digital Retinal Imaging?

DRI is an image of your internal eye (retina, macular, optic nerve and vessels) and anterior eye (cornea, conjunctiva and eye lids).

Why do I need a Digital Retinal Imaging?

Recording the images allows the Optometrist to detect subtle changes between visits and monitor and manage specific conditions. Detecting early changes allows early treatment and more options for treatment.

It is recommended for all initial consultations and is part of a comprehensive eye examination.

It is particularly useful in managing and detecting changes associated with macular degeneration, glaucoma, hypertension, cholesterol, diabetes and cancers of the eye.

Currently Digital Retinal Imaging is not covered under Medicare and is \$39.

Please inform the Optometrist if you do not wish to have Digital Retinal Imaging performed and recorded for future assessments.
